OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health) GUIDELINES FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF AMBIGUITY IN THE MARKET PLACE AS IT RELATES TO NON HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS and / or PRODUCTS

Statement to be provided to any entity requesting a SDS for any non hazardous product or materials not classified as hazardous under the OSHA HazCom 29CFR1910.1200 standards.

“Items that are not hazardous or that are specifically exempt in the OSHA HazCom 29CFR1910.1200 (Toxic Hazardous Substance Standard) do not require an SDS. Section G2 of the OSHA inspection procedures for the HazCom standard explicitly states the standard requires SDS's only for hazardous chemicals. The HCS (Hazardous Communication Standards) does not require manufacturers, or importers, to supply SDS's for non-hazardous chemicals.”

Nonetheless, some downstream clients may still insist on SDS in cases where one is not required. If you encounter someone who will not accept a verbal assurance OSHA has suggested providing a written statement such as

“ “ This product is not considered to be or to contain hazardous chemicals based on evaluations made by our company under the OSHA standard OSHA HazCom 29CFR1910.1200 ””
